**Miniature / Art Quilt**, 24" maximum on any side

**Challenge Quilt** "Make it 25" maximum perimeter 100"

To celebrate our 25th Quilt show, the challenge is to use '25' in your quilt. For example, 25 blocks.....the number 25 applied on it, something silver to denote the silver anniversary - just "Make it 25"!

All quilts require a sleeve. Bed and Lap quilts will need a 4" sleeve, while smaller quilts can have a 2" sleeve.

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**Tips for writing your quilt's "story" for the show:** What was your inspiration? Did you make it for a special person? To commemorate a special event? Did you learn this technique in a class? Don't forget to give your quilt an interesting title!

**Tips for submitting a photo of your quilt:** A small photo (approximately 3"x 5": or 4"x 6" is preferred. No need to print your photo on expensive photo paper - copy paper is fine.

**Challenge Quilt "Make it 25"** To celebrate our 25th Quilt show, the challenge is to use '25' in your quilt. For example, 25 blocks.....the number 25 incorporated on it, 25 cows on it, or 25 different critters - just "Make it 25"! The quilt can be any design you like, any color, cut no bigger than 100" around the perimeter. A sleeve is required.

All quilts must have a sleeve sewn, not pinned, to the back. Bed and Lap quilts will need a 4" sleeve, while smaller quilts can have a 2" sleeve. Instructions for making and attaching a sleeve for hanging can be found all over the web - or just ask a friendly member of the guild.

Each member of the guild is encouraged to enter a quilt in the show.

Each entrant must be a current guild member and must have participated in the making of the quilt.

Entries must not have been exhibited in a previous FCQG Quilt Show.

The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to edit quilt descriptions or reassign categories as needed.
