

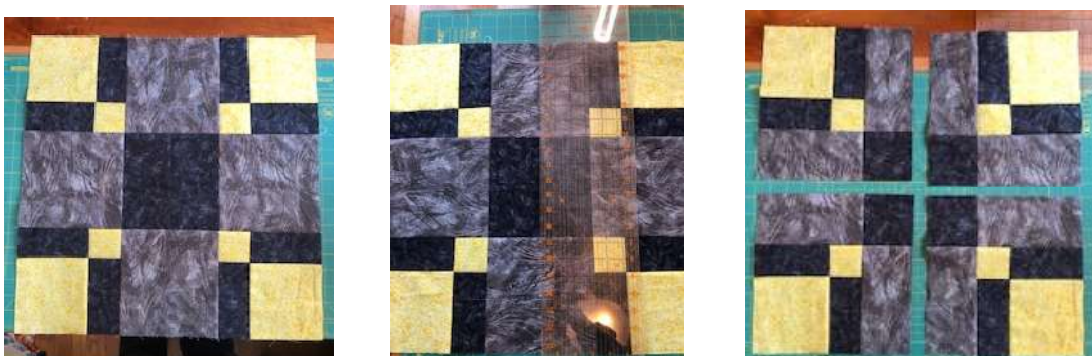
DOUBLE DISAPPEARING NINE PATCH

- (5) 5-inch squares, yellow
- (4) 5-inch squares, medium to dark gray
- (1) 7-inch squares, medium/dark gray
- (4) 7-inch squares, light/medium gray

- Create a nine patch with the five inch squares as pictured. Your block will measure 14 inches square. Cut the 9-patch in both directions down the center (7 inches from each side or $2\frac{1}{4}$ inches from the seam line) to make four quarters.



- Slide the 7-inch quarters out to become the corners of a second nine patch. Place your 7-inch medium/dark gray square in the center and the (4) 7-inch light/medium gray squares in the middle edge positions. Sew the nine patch together, then cut in both directions down the center (10 inches from each side) to make four quarters.



- Rearrange the four quarters by rotating the top right and the bottom left 180 degrees so that the center is at the outside corner for 2 diagonal quarters. Sew the block back together. Your block is now 19.5 inches square.
