Fabric requirements:

$\frac{2}{3}$ yard main fabric

$\frac{1}{3}$ yard lining fabric

Supply List:

- Thread to match or coordinate
- Helpful tools: tube turner, ruler; fabric marking pen; cutting mat; rotary blade; and 1 straight- edge rotary cutting ruler.
- 18" pillow form or pillow

Homework:

- Find three 4½" unfinished orphan blocks that coordinate with your main fabric or make them. In my example, I use a 4" finished economy block. Flying geese, 4 patches would be great too.
- Sew the 3 blocks together making a 4½" x 12½" rectangle.
