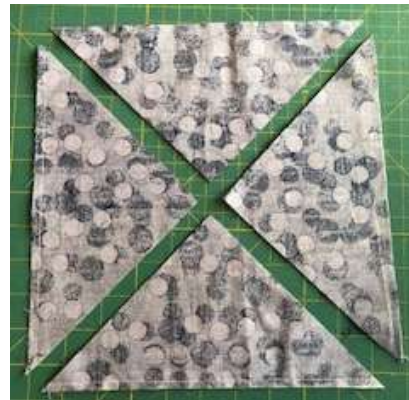


Mystery Disappearing Pinwheel Block

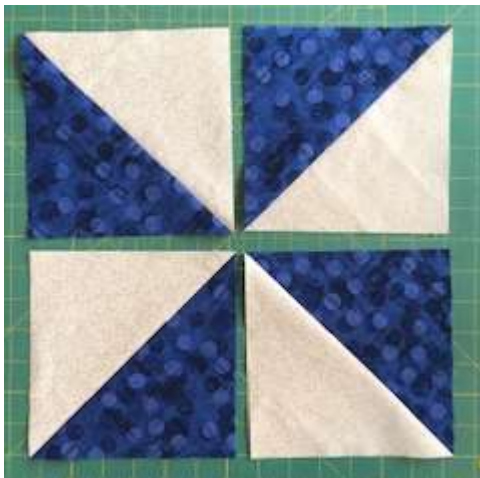
1 – 10-inch Blue Square

1 – 10-inch White Square

1. Take the 2 squares of fabric and with right sides together, sew a 1/4" seam around the outside of the block (all four sides).
2. Cut block diagonally corner to corner both ways. You now have 4 half-square triangles (HST), trim to 6 5/8 inches square. Press to the blue.



3. Orient the 4 half-square triangles (HST) as pictured to make the pinwheel block. Sew and press. The block will now measure 12.75 inches.



4. Cut the block 4 1/4 inches from each edge, rotating the block 45 degrees to make four cuts.



5. You now have nine pieces, 1 pinwheel center, 4 half-square triangles, 4 bar blocks, each measuring $4\frac{1}{4}$ inches square.
6. The mystery is how **you** will rearrange these nine blocks to make a new block. There is a dozen or more ways to put the block together. Move them around, turn them around, until you find your favorite setting. Sew them together, press. Your block should now measure 11.75 inches square.
