

November Scrappy Block of the Month

Tree Block (Pattern taken from You Tube Tree quilt Blocks by Mostly Quilts)

ALL pieces will be using 2 ½ inch strips

Tree fabric: you can get creative here! (use different greens or multicolors)!

For each tree block you will need: 1 - 4 ½ x 2 ½, 1 - 6 ½ x 2 ½, 1- 8 ½ x 2 ½, 1 - 10 ½ x 2 ½ strip

Trunk fabric : one 2 ½" square

Background: this fabric can be light or dark- just a strong contrast with tree and trunk

2 each of:

5 ½ x 2 ½, 3 ½ x 2 ½, 2 ½ x 2 ½,

and 4 each - 4 ½ x 2 ½

Lay out your fabric pieces so you can see your tree block.

Take your background pieces and place them at a right angle to the tree fabric. You can mark a diagonal 45 degree line with a pencil on the wrong side of the background piece. (See Hint), then sew on that line Check to be sure the pieces line up before trimming off your ¼". Trim and press before adding the opposite side piece.

HINT :The 45 degree diagonal lines on the left side of the tree will slant up left to right towards the center of the tree fabric; the lines on the right side of the tree will slant right to left up to the center of the tree fabric.

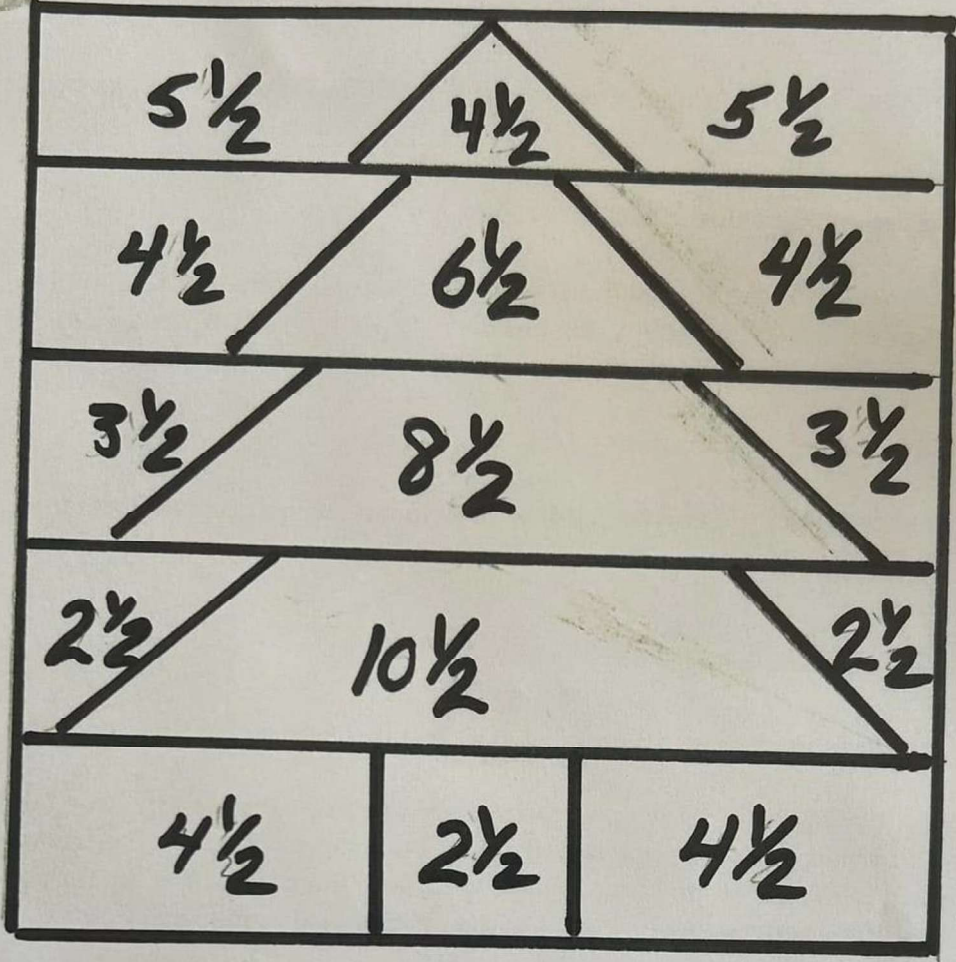
Make each row and then sew rows together. Happy Scrapping!!

Unfinished block should measure 10 ¼ x 10 ¼"
