

Disappearing 9-Patch Quilt Block

1 – 5 inch Green Square

4 – 5 inch Light to Medium Fall Color (Red, Yellow, Orange)

4 – 5 inch Medium to Dark Fall Color (Red, Yellow, Orange)

Lay your 9 squares out in 3 rows of 3 squares to make a simple 9 patch. The green square in the center and the two fall colors alternating around the center. Sew together using a quarter inch seam allowance. Your block should now measure 14 inches square. (if not please check your $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam)



You will now cut the square in half vertically and horizontally. This can be done using a cutting mat and cut at 7 inches. I used a ruler to measure 2.25 inches from the seam line and cut. Either way will work.



Now comes the fun part – Take two opposite corners and rotate them 180 degrees, and sew them together.



Your block now measures 13.5 inches square.

The block can be made scrappy (1 green, 4 different yellow, 4 different red).
