## March 22, 2019 Franklin County Quilters Guild Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6PM by President John Rouleau. There were 27 members present. John read two Thank You notes the Guild received for our donations of Comfort Quilts, one from Janet McCarthy, the Executive Director of Franklin County Home Health and the other from Adrienne Perrino of Bags for Love.

The Minutes of the February meeting were accepted with the change of the date of the Rag Quilt workshop from 2/23 to 2/24 on a motion from Bonnie Evans, 2<sup>---</sup> by Kay Benedict. Due to the Treasurer's trip to Italy, there was no March 2019 financial report.

**Quilt Show:** It was announced that there were still opportunities for members to volunteer before, after and during the show. There are also appointments still available for quilt appraisals. Kay Benedict announced that there are 76 quilts registered for the show and that with the Raffle, Charity and Comfort quilts on display, there will be over 100 quilts for attendees to view. Kay also gave directions on how quilts should be prepared for the show. The will be accepted on Friday 4/5 from noon to 2 PM.

**Program:** Due to the snow storm, Jessica's VanDenburgh's presentation on color has been rescheduled to Friday, June 21<sup>st</sup>. The Guild's June meeting and program will be held at the Church of the Rock. Her workshop on making bags will be on the 21<sup>st</sup> as well, during the daytime at Northwestern Medical Center.


The **Teacup Auction and Potluck** will take place at the May meeting.

**Fundraising:** Through the Guild's fundraising efforts \$1,020 has been raised to purchase supplies for Comfort Quilts and \$1,500 was raised to sponsor the Quilt Show. We do not charge admission for the Quilt Show and sponsors are sought to help defray the costs of renting City Hall, liability insurance, publicity for the show, etc.

**Block of the Month:** The quilt block, Box Kite was introduced. It will be 12.5 inches unfinished. The pattern can be located on Quilter's Cache and some printed directions were passed out at the meeting.

The membership drawing was won by Cathy. The meeting closed with Show and Tell.
