

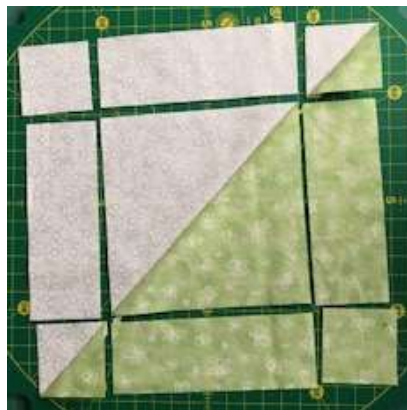
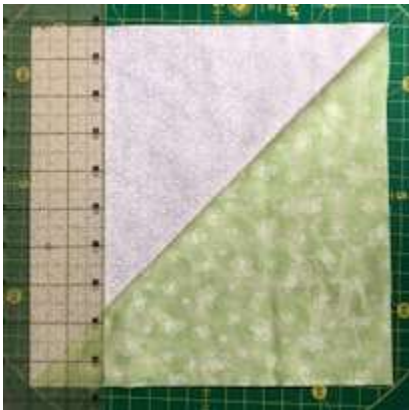
Disappearing Half Square Triangle (HST)

These instructions make 2 blocks, 8 inches finished.

1 – 10-inch square White Fabric

1 – 10-inch square Pastel Fabric – think spring

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the white square. Place the white square and the pastel square rights side together. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch away on both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line. Press to the pastel and trim to $9\frac{1}{2}$ inches square. You now have two HST.
- With one HST at a time, measure and cut 2 inches in from all 4 sides.



- Switch the White rectangles with the Pastel rectangles. Sew the block together. The block is now $8\frac{1}{2}$ inches square.
