

DISAPPEARING HARLEQUIN BLOCK

4 – 5-inch Red Squares

4 – 5-inch Blue Squares

8 – 5-inch White Squares

OR

8 – 4.5 inch Red and White Half Square Triangles - HST

8 – 4.5-inch Blue and White Half Square Triangles- HST

- If starting with 5-inch squares draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the white squares, then put four white squares right sides together with each to red and blue squares. Sew on both sides of the line, cut on the line press open to the dark color and trim to 4.5 inches square.



1. Take two red HST, be careful that you have the correct orientation as pictured, sew together. Repeat with the blue HST. Make 4 of each color.



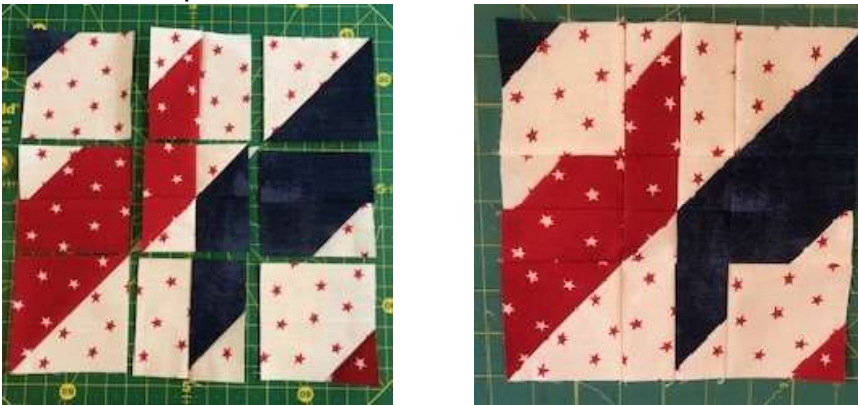
2. Take one red block and one blue block (making sure the red block is on the left) sew together as pictured. This is the Harlequin Block measuring 8.5 inches square. Make 4



3. Now for the disappearing part, take one harlequin block cut the block $1\frac{3}{8}$ inch from the center sewn line, rotating the block 45 degrees to make four cuts.



4. Swap the top left block with the bottom right block and sew together. The block now measure 7.5 inches square. Make 4.



5. Take your four blocks and rotate them so the red triangle corner is in the center. Sew together. The block now measures 14.5 inches.
