

Disappearing Pinwheel Block

1 – 10-inch Purple Square

1 – 10-inch Cream Square

1. Take the 2 squares of fabric and with right sides together, sew a 1/4" seam around the outside of the block (all four sides).
2. Cut block diagonally corner to corner both ways. You now have 4 half-square triangles measuring 6.75 inches square. Press to the purple.



3. To ensure our pinwheels all spin in the same direction lay 2 of the squares with the light in the upper left corner and 2 with the dark in the upper right corner. Sew together. Rotate the top piece to make the pinwheel block. Sew and press. The block will now measure 13 inches.



4. Now to disappear we will cut the block $2 \frac{1}{8}$ inch from the center, rotating the block 45 degrees to make four cuts.



5. You now have nine pieces, 1 pinwheel center, 4 half-square triangles, 4 bar blocks. We will only rotate the bar blocks 180 degrees, once this is done the block colors will be opposite each other. Sew and press. The block now measures 12 inches.
